UPCOMING PROJECT INFORMATION CITY OF YOUNGSTOWN LINCOLN AVENUE IMPROVEMENTS

MAH-Lincoln Avenue; PID 97932

The city of Youngstown plans improvements to enhance pedestrian safety along Lincoln Avenue from Fifth Avenue east to Wick Avenue. The project involves roadway resurfacing, new curb/gutter and curb ramps, sidewalk, street lighting, crosswalks, landscaping, and new street signs and pavement striping.

The proposed project will not impact any cultural resources, suspect hazardous waste sites or ecological resources. The project will not result in substantial impacts to the environment either individually or cumulatively. In compliance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended (codified as 36 CFR 800), The city of Youngstown requests information regarding the presence of any known cultural resources in the vicinity of the project. Cultural resources include prehistoric and historic archaeological sites, historic bridges, historic buildings, sites and districts.

The transportation improvement is scheduled for construction in the summer of 2016 and is expected to be completed within one construction season. The estimated construction cost is approximately \$1,237,500. During project construction, eastbound traffic will be maintained at all times. Westbound traffic will be detoured onto Rayen Avenue for approximately 90 days. Additionally, pedestrian traffic and access to adjacent properties will be maintained at all times during construction activities.
