

M. J. Joseph Development Corporation announces plans to construct a \$20 million beverage and technology complex

Joseph Company International has announced the company's plans to invest \$20 million to build a beverage and technology complex in Youngstown, Ohio that will produce the world's first and only self-chilling beverage can. The project is estimated to create 257 new jobs for the city as well as provide a destination of interest, as the technology will be showcased globally. Youngstown City Council authorized a Development Agreement with the Company at their October 17, 2016 Council meeting and Board of Control finalized the agreement on October 21, 2016.

Development plans call for building four large production buildings and an East Coast Administrative headquarters in an area bounded by Oak Street, Fruit Street, Hillman Ave, and the Madison Avenue Expressway (US 62/SR 7). Plans are to have production buildings complete by late summer 2017 and in full operation by 2018. A groundbreaking is expected to occur in November.
